WORK TO BEGIN ON COUNTY TRUNK HIGHWAY M (WASAUKEE RD)

Reconstruction of County Trunk Highway (CTH) M (Wasaukee Road), from Freistadt Road to 1.5 Miles North in the Village of Germantown and City of Mequon is scheduled to begin on **Monday, July 17, 2023** and be substantially completed by November.

The prime contractor for the project is Vinton Construction Company from Manitowoc, Wisconsin. The construction project will be closed to through traffic from the Mid-July to November. Improvements will include: grading, asphalt, curb and gutter, storm sewer, culvert pipes, and sight line improvements.

Please follow the posted detour routes utilizing **CTH M, Freistadt Road, STH 145, CTH G and CTH T**. Local residents are asked to use extra caution when driving in the construction area and to obey all flagmen and construction signs. Alternate routes should be utilized if possible to avoid delays. Access will remain open to local businesses.
