PERMIT APPLICATION REVIEW FORM INSTRUCTIONS

The PERMIT APPLICATION REVIEW FORM is primarily used to verify that a County Permit is not needed for a proposed project on a parcel. The proposed project must:

- 1) Lie outside of the jurisdictional Shoreland, Wetland, Floodplain Zoning areas;
- 2) Have proper setback distances from the septic system and well; and
- 3) Does not need an Erosion Control or Stormwater Management Permit.

If staff verify that a County permit is not needed we will provide you a copy of the signed PERMIT APPLICATION REVIEW FORM, that can then be brought to your local municipality (town/village). The local municipality will review and have you complete any final permits or approvals before starting your project. If a County permit is needed staff will indicate that on the form and will help guide you through the permit process.

In addition to the below instructions, a website mapping application has been created to provide you with the information needed to complete the PERMIT APPLICATION REVIEW FORM. The website mapping application also provides information on other permits that may be needed for your project.

1) Find your property, begin by typing in your name, address or tax key in the "Search" area. Select the correct information from the search box to ZOOM into the parcel. In this example, the owner's name was typed as "WASHINGTON COUNTY"



The ownership and permit information will pop-up in a rectangular box near your parcel. Use the scroll bar in the box to read through all the information provided to determine which permits may be required for your project.

To visibly verify if your project is located within a shoreland zone, you may need to zoom out to find the extent of the Shoreland Zoning areas which is the thick RED LINES. Your parcel may intersect with the shoreland zoning area <u>however</u>, your project may lie outside of the shoreland zoning area <u>however</u>, your project may lie outside of the shoreland zoning area.

• If your project is located WITHIN the shoreland zone, you will need the SHORELAND ZONING PERMIT and/or ADMINISTRATIVE/CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT not a PERMIT APPLICATION REVIEW FORM. Note: Shoreland zoning is considered to be the area within 1,000 feet of a navigable lake, pond or flowage or 300 feet within a navigable river or stream.

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2) If you have determined that your project lies OUTSIDE of the Shoreland Zoning area, please fill out the PERMIT APPLICATION REVIEW FORM.



3) Next, scroll down in the pop-up box - click a link named "CURRENT POWTS PERMIT INFORMATION" to find all your "Ownership Information" needed to complete the PERMIT APPLICATION REVIEW FORM. See the screenshot to the right.

Assure that your project is meeting the setback requirements from the septic system – A structure must be at least 10 feet away from the septic drainage field (15 feet away – if it is down slope from a mound) and 5 feet away from a septic tank or holding tank. A swimming pool must be at least 15 feet away from a septic drainage field (SPS 383.43 Table 1). The majority of septic system site plans have been scanned and can be found on this link – unfortunately we don't have septic permits on septic systems installed before 1969.



4) When you click on the **CURRENT POWTS PERMIT INFORMATION** link the you will see the following screenshot.

Within this "Property Summary" pop up box near the bottom, you will find **SANITARY PERMIT #'s** colored in **RED** under **Permit #**. **FIND AND CLICK ON YOUR ACTIVE SANITARY PERMIT NUMBER.**

For this example we clicked on permit **# 289247**. This screen contains information regarding your Sanitary Permit.

5) To view the Permit and Site Plans - CLICK ON THE "DOCUMENT" BUTTON (red with white text).

• THEN CLICK "OPEN". The sanitary documents have been scanned as TIF or PDF images. Please review the documents to ensure your project will meet the minimum setback requirements mentioned above. If you do meet the requirements, please print and attach the septic site plan to the PERMIT APPLICATION REVIEW FORM.

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How to submit your PERMIT APPLICATION REVIEW FORM – ONLINE

 Please fill out the PERMIT APPLICATION REVIEW FORM in its entirety – use the information from the "CURRENT POWTS PERMIT INFORMATION" screen, including your contact information. SAVE THE DOCUMENT TO YOUR COMPUTER.

DO NOT FILL IN THE INFORMATION BELOW THE RED LINE ON THE FORM WHICH STATES: (FOR DEPARTMENT USE – DO NOT FILL IN BELOW THIS LINE)

THAT AREA WILL BE FILLED IN BY AN INSPECTOR.

2) You can either use the web application to draw where your proposed project will be located on your property, or by hand after printing the map. Please draw your project as close to scale as possible and indicate your projects dimensions. An Aerial Photo, Plat Map, Certified Survey Map or a Septic Site Plan Map can also be used to indicate where your proposed project will be located on your property. Please identify where your septic system and well is located on the map. A drawing and brief description of your proposed project is required and needs to be submitted along with the application.



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- 3) Save all your documents to your computer. Documents can be submitted as jpg, tiff, docx, or pdf's.
- 4) Open your email and send your saved PERMIT APPLICATION REVIEW FORM, site map and any other attachments to the following email address: <u>PermitAR@co.washington.wi.us</u>

Washington County Land Resource Inspectors will review your information and if needed contact you via email or phone to discuss your project. Upon approval, the PERMIT APPLICATION REVIEW will be signed by an Inspector and emailed back to you. Please provide the signed PERMIT APPLICATION REVIEW FORM to your TOWN or VILLAGE CLERK.

Please allow 7-10 working days for staff to review your PERMIT APPLICATION REVIEW FORM request. If you do not hear back from us within the 7-10 day period, please contact our office at 262.335.4445.
