
Weighing **Tradeoffs**

B. ...longer and meandering through scenic areas and away from traffic.














Holy Hill Road-Freistadt Road




Germantown to Bugline Trail








Remaining Network

 - Bridge rebuilt
 - Intersection rebuilt as roundabout
- Incremental
 - Low-cost investments (signed bike routes)




